Current class descriptions:

Baby and Me:

A beginner level class for parents/caregivers and babies. (18 Months to 2.5 years old. It is a time to enjoy music, crafts, and play. There will sessions Fall, winter, and spring.

2 ¹/₂ year old Toddler Time Program:

These classes are designed for preschoolers, providing a relaxed introduction to the educational environment and focusing on developing basic social skills. The purpose of these classes is to help trigger the development of a child's most basic and fundamental social skills. All children must be **2** ½ by **September 30**th to enroll for fall classes. A child may start the program once they are 2 ½ during the school year. Children **do not need to be potty trained** to attend this class.

3-year-old program 2-day:

This class is planned for the 3 year old that may not have had any previous preschool experience. The purpose of this class is to help the child develop social skills, become involved in-group activities and make new friends. All children must be 3 years old by September 30th and totally potty trained to enroll in this class.

3-year-old program 3-day:

These classes are somewhat more comprehensive than the 2-day class due primarily to more time spent in the classroom, as well as slightly more involved activities. The nurturing of basic three-year-old appropriate social skills is still their primary purpose. **Children must be 3 years old by September 30**th **and totally potty trained to enroll in this class.**

4&5-year program 3-day:

This class is designed for 4- and 5-year-olds who want to socialize, learn and play to get ready for kindergarten. The curriculum is filled with science, math, literature, phonetics, imagination and play. The class is run in a welcoming and fun atmosphere. Children must be 4 years old by September 30th and totally potty trained to enroll in these classes.

4&5 year old program Pre-K Program 4 or 5 day

This class is designed for the younger 5 year old that is ready for an everyday routine but not quite equipped to handle the structure or demands of Kindergarten. The child may be moving up from one of our other programs or joining us for the very first time. These students are challenged to grow socially, and to be exposed to a wide variety of developmentally appropriate readiness activities that are provided via benefits of a consistent daily routine. This class is an excellent final preparation for the child who needs a little more "growing time" before moving onto kindergarten. **Children must be 4 years old by June 1.**

Preschool Extended Day Enrichment

The Preschool Extended Day Enrichment (PEDE) program is intended to provide students with the opportunity to be involved in an in-depth developmentally appropriate preschool experience based on a variety of curriculum topics.

Enrollment Eligibility:

Students with three and five day classes at HUMNS will be eligible for full year enrollment, with classes starting in mid-September. Registration will take place at the same time as regular registration.

Enrollment Procedures:

11:30-1:30 All 12 enrichment students eat parent provided lunch with the enrichment teachers. They will also have gym, stories, and games during this time.

Tuition:

The PEDE tuition will be paid in advance each semester. There will be no refunds or substitutions for classes missed due to student absences.

Parent Responsibilities:

Parental responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- 1. Complete all registration procedures
- 2. Pay tuition on time
- 3. Make every effort to arrive promptly at arrival and departure
- 4. Provide student with a nutritious lunch remembering no nuts.
- 5. Notify staff in writing if someone other than parent will be picking up

Explorer Program

The Explorer Program is intended to provide students with the opportunity to be involved in an in-depth developmentally appropriate preschool experience based on a wide variety of topics.

Enrollment Eligibility:

Students enrolled in any 4 or 5-year-old classes at HUMNS will be eligible for full year enrollment with classes starting mid-September. Registration will take place at the same time as regular registration.
